PRESS RELEASE: Armée Nationale-Imbonezagutabara pursues its mission to liberate Rwanda

Armée Nationale- Imbonezagutabara (AN-Imbonezagutabara), the military wing of the Rally for Unity and Democracy (RUD-URUNANA) and Rally of the Rwandan People (RPR) informs the public that one of his former officers has returned to Rwanda. Colonel Rushidi was once one of the officers assigned to the office of the Commander in charge of military operations within the AN-Imbonezagutabara. His decision to return to Rwanda is personal; the commitment to the struggle is based on one's commitment and capabilities.

The appalling political situation and relentless repression in Rwanda constitutes an unbearable barrier to political, social, and economic participation of the Rwandan people. Hence, the AN-Imbonezagutabara remains committed to the struggle against the repressive and murderous regime of RPF-Inkotanyi led by Paul Kagame until the regime respects the aspirations of the Rwandan people, stops the massacres and the repression directed against the Rwandan people and ends its bloody adventures in the Great Lakes region in general and the DRC, in particular.

Thus, we reaffirm that:

Every Rwandan has the right to return to Rwanda and enjoy his or her inalienable basic human rights;

Contrary to the false statements in the media, no commander of the AN-Imbonezagutabara has returned to Rwanda. Colonel Rushidi was neither among the commanders nor in the command structure;

The National Army - Imbonezagutabara continues its mission to protect Rwandan refugees in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC);

The AN-Imbonezagutabara remains committed to the struggle against the bloody regime of the RPF Inkotanyi led by General Paul Kagame.

The High Command and the troops of the AN-Imbonezagutabara express their gratitude to the Rwandan people in general and the members of RUD-Urunana and RPR in particular and renew their commitment to continue the mission of protecting refugees and liberating the country from the repressive and bloody regime of General Paul Kagame.
